## Some Farewells

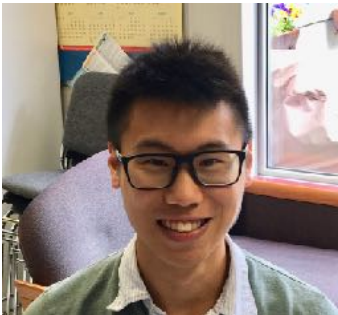
