Stay Informed with SchoolMessenger Text Alerts (Opt-In)

Our District uses SchoolMessenger to share important school and district updates, including weather closures, emergency notifications, reminders, and time-sensitive announcements.

All families with a current cell phone number in our MyEdBC database will receive a text message from SchoolMessenger (Text #: 978338) in February 2026. To start receiving text alerts, you will need to opt in.

How to opt in:

1. Watch for a text from SchoolMessenger (Text #: 978338).
2. Reply with "Y" to 978338.
3. You will receive a confirmation message letting you know you're successfully subscribed.

Want alerts on more than one device?

To receive text alerts on multiple phones, each phone number must opt in separately by replying "Y" to 978338.

Dates of Significance

JANUARY

January 15-Black Excellence Day: Created by the Ninandotoo Society to rejoice and learn about the stories, art, and history of Black people.

January 17-Raoul Wallenberg Day: A day to recognize Raoul Wallenberg for his work in saving tens of thousands of Hungarian Jews during the Holocaust.

January 21- Lincoln Alexander Day: The birthday of Honourable Lincoln Alexander has been recognized across Canada since 2015. He was a pioneer in the fight for racial equity in Canada. Alexander's legacy is marked by many firsts as the first Black Member of Parliament, Cabinet minister, and Lieutenant-Governor of Ontario.

January 23-Vasant Panchami: A day that is believed to be the birth of the Goddess Saraswati, and is dedicated to this Hindu Goddess of knowledge, music, arts, wisdom and learning.

January 24-World Day for African and Afrodescendant Culture: A day to celebrate and highlight the contributions of the many vibrant cultures of the African continent and the African people around the world, as well as their role in driving sustainable development, dialogue, and peace.

Updated Volunteer Driver Form

The process for volunteering as a parent driver for field trips and after-school extracurricular activities has been updated.

Going forward, all volunteer drivers are required to complete an electronic Criminal Record Check (CRC) through the Province of British Columbia using a district-provided access code. When using the school district code, there is no cost to volunteers. Criminal record checks can be completed online:

In addition, all drivers must provide proof of a minimum of \$1 million in third-party liability insurance. Criminal record checks and insurance documents may be kept on file and updated every two years. However, the Volunteer Driver Form must be completed annually.

Whenever possible, the school continues to use school-district buses, private bus companies, or public transit for field trips. Thank you for helping us keep student safety a top priority

Washroom Use

Dear Parents and Guardians,

We are reaching out to ask for your help and support with an ongoing concern regarding student use of the washrooms at Tomsett. Unfortunately, both the boys' and girls' washrooms are not being respected, and staff are frequently required to respond to significant messes.

On an ongoing basis, we are finding that some students are not using toilets or urinals appropriately. In boys' washrooms, there have been repeated incidents of urine on the floor, in sinks, and in garbage cans. We have also seen entire rolls of toilet paper unrolled and placed into toilets, wet paper towels thrown onto walls and ceilings, and writing on washroom walls. These incidents are happening far too often and create unhygienic conditions for everyone.

We have addressed this issue with students through classroom discussions, school-wide reminders, and announcements. Despite these efforts, the problem continues, which is why we are now asking for your partnership.

We kindly request that families take time to review washroom expectations and respectful behavior at home. Please talk with your child about:

- Using the toilet or urinal properly and only for its intended purpose
- Never urinating on floors, in sinks, or in garbage cans
- Respecting shared spaces so they remain clean and safe for everyone
- Understanding that damaging or misusing school property affects the entire school community

Teaching and reinforcing these expectations at home makes a significant difference. When students receive consistent messages from both school and family, they are far more likely to make responsible choices.

Please be aware that if these behaviours continue, the school may need to introduce additional measures, such as students signing in to use the washroom or signing out of class, to help monitor and reduce incidents.

We truly appreciate your understanding, support, and cooperation as we work together to teach responsibility, respect, and care for shared spaces.

Thank you for partnering with us to ensure our school remains a clean, safe, and respectful environment for all.
