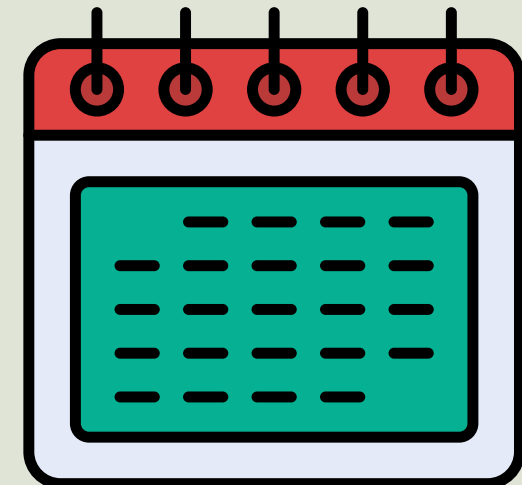

Dates of Significance

MARCH

March is Irish Heritage Month: March was declared Irish Heritage Month in the House of Commons in 2022. Irish Heritage Month celebrates Irish Canadians' contributions to Canada's story and serves as an opportunity to learn more about Irish-Canadian history.

March 1: Zero Discrimination Day - A UN recognized day to take action to end the inequalities surrounding income, sex, age, health status, occupation, disability, sexual orientation, drug use, gender identity, race, class, ethnicity and religion that continue to persist around the world. Often used to highlight discrimination of people living with HIV.

March 2-3: Purim - A Jewish celebration that is a lively festival that commemorates back in the 4th century BC, when Jewish people were saved from a death decree according to the book of Esther

March 3: Lantern Festival - A Chinese celebration that marks the end of the Lunar New Year.

March 3: Magha Puja Day - A major holy day observed by most Buddhists on the first full moon day of the third lunar month. A day of prayers, chants, and offerings.

March 4-6: Hola Mohalla - A colourful 3-day Sikh festival celebrated during spring.

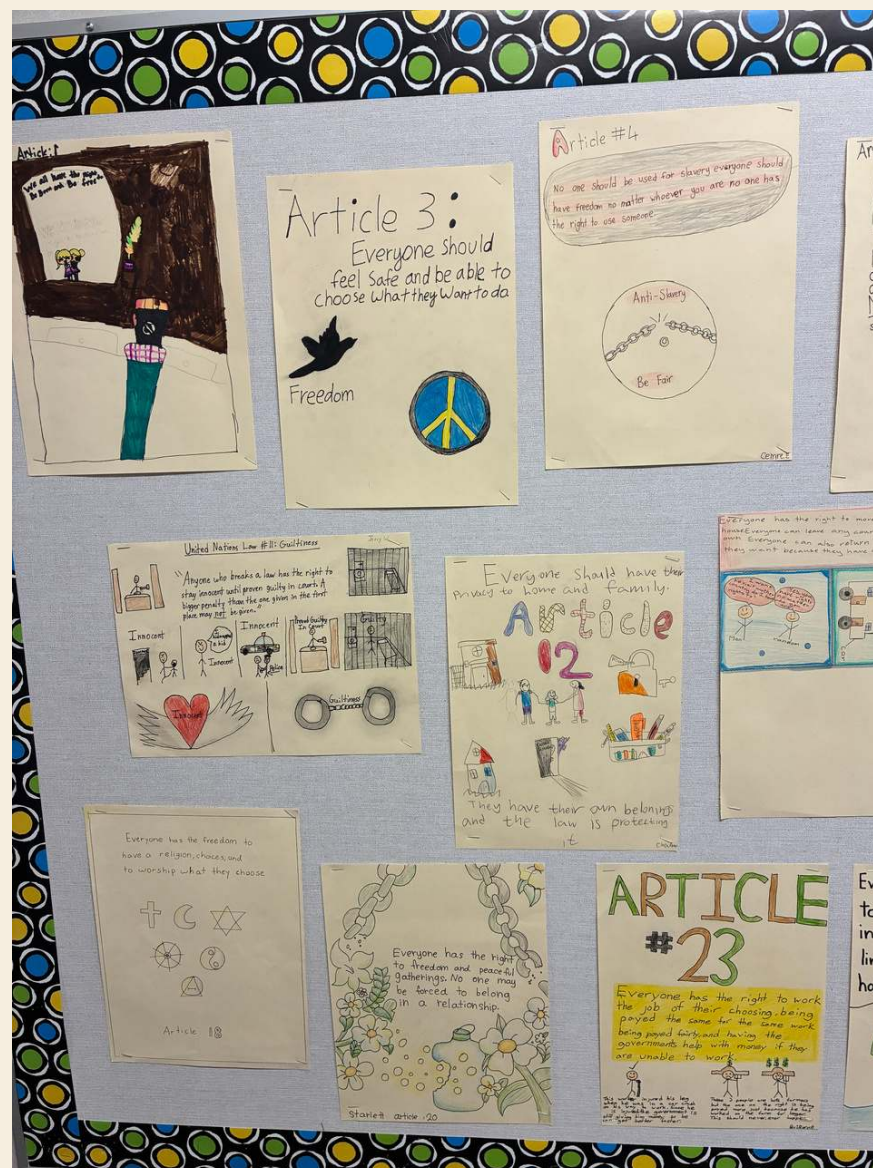
Around the School
