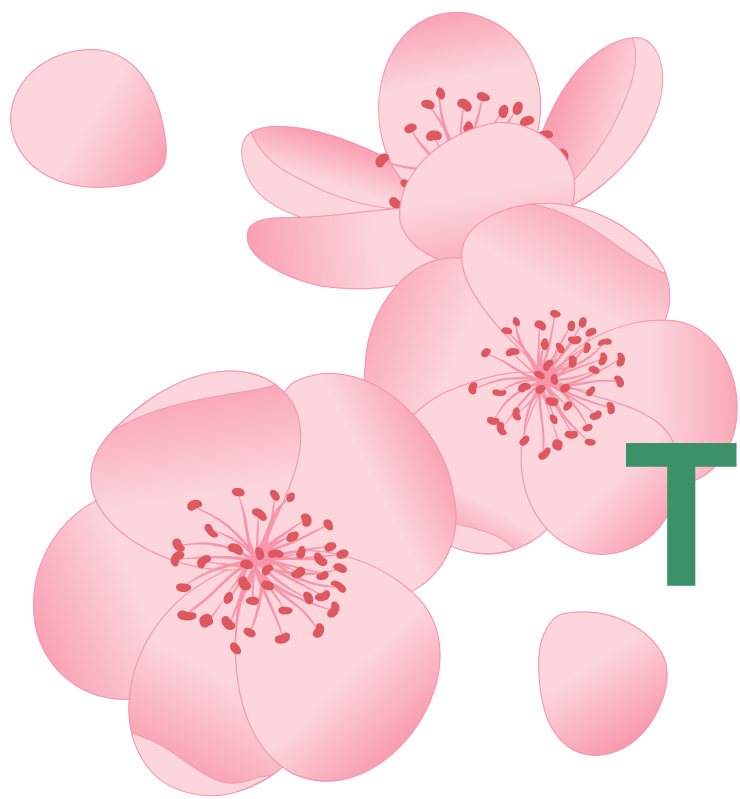

Here are a few reminders for the week ahead:

- **Parking Lot Safety**-We hope you received our email regarding Drop Off and Pick Up Reminders. Please do not drop students off on Odlin Road. This area is not designed for student drop-off and creates unsafe conditions for both pedestrians and drivers.
 - Instead, we ask that all families:
 - Use the parking lot loop for drop-off
 - Pull forward into the designated drop-off zones before letting students out
 - Remain in your vehicle and keep the flow of traffic moving
 - Avoid parking or leaving your vehicle unattended in the drop-off zone

With the warmer weather arriving, we also encourage families, when possible, to walk to school or park a short distance away and walk in together. This helps reduce congestion and supports a safe and calm start to the day.

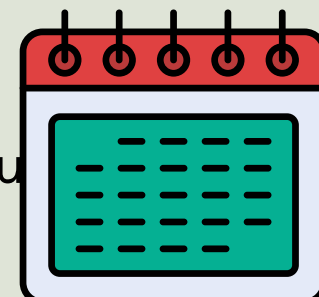

Dates of Significance

APRIL

April is:

Autism Awareness Month: A month to come together to increase understanding and awareness of autism and to help end the stigma and discrimination that some Autistic people experience.

Genocide Remembrance, Condemnation, and Prevention Month: A month to honour the memory of the victims of genocide and reflect on the root causes of these tragedies.

Sikh Heritage Month: A month to recognize and highlight the important contributions that Sikh communities have made and continue to make to Canada's social, economic, political, and cultural heritage.

April 13-14: Baisakhi or Vaisakhi – A harvest festival celebrated in India, mainly by the Sikh community.

April 13-14: Yom Hashoah (Holocaust and Heroism Remembrance Day) – This annual day is designated by the State of Israel in remembrance of the victims of the Holocaust and is observed by Jewish communities worldwide

April 14: International Day of Pink – An opportunity to renew our commitment to diversity and inclusion by combatting all forms of discrimination that fuel bullying and violence, which many 2SLGBTQ+ youth continue to face.

April 14-20: Bangla Heritage Week – A week to celebrate the contributions and culture of the Bengali speaking people.
