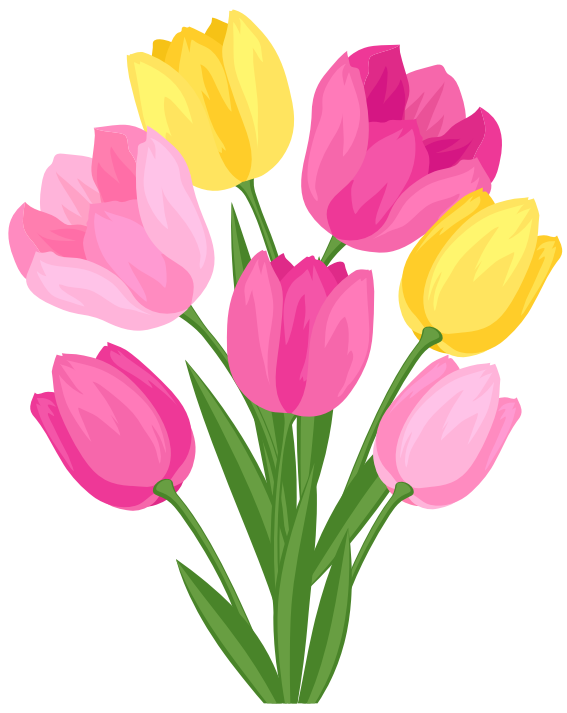

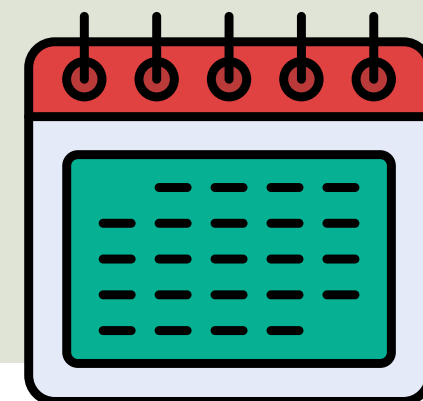

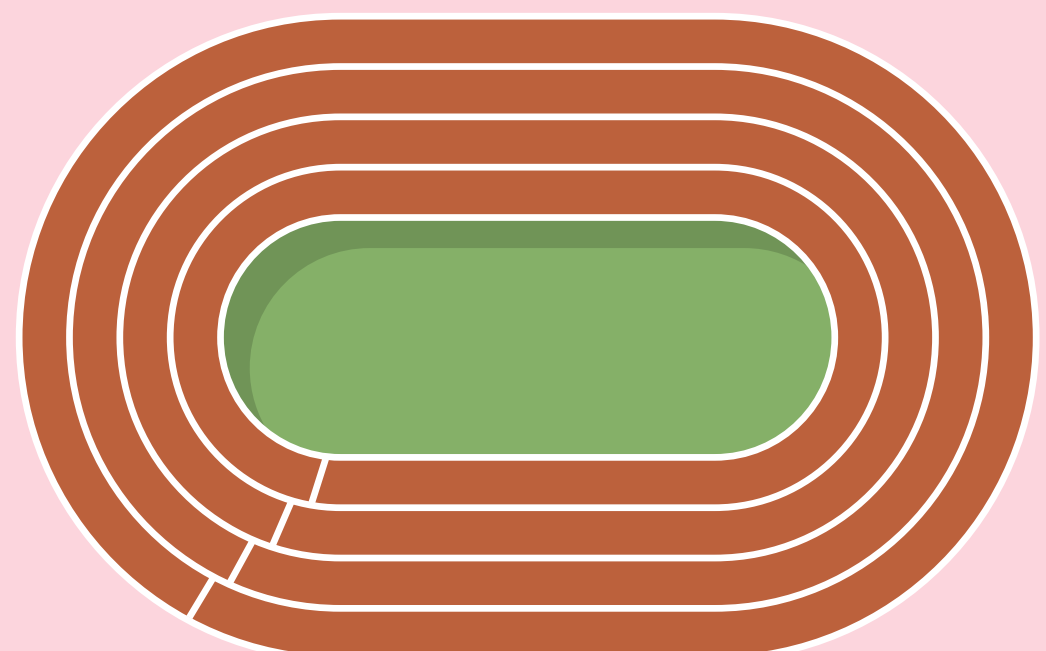
Elementary Track & Field Survey.

To make the week even more exciting, we'll be tracking how students arrive at school each day. Classes will earn points for:

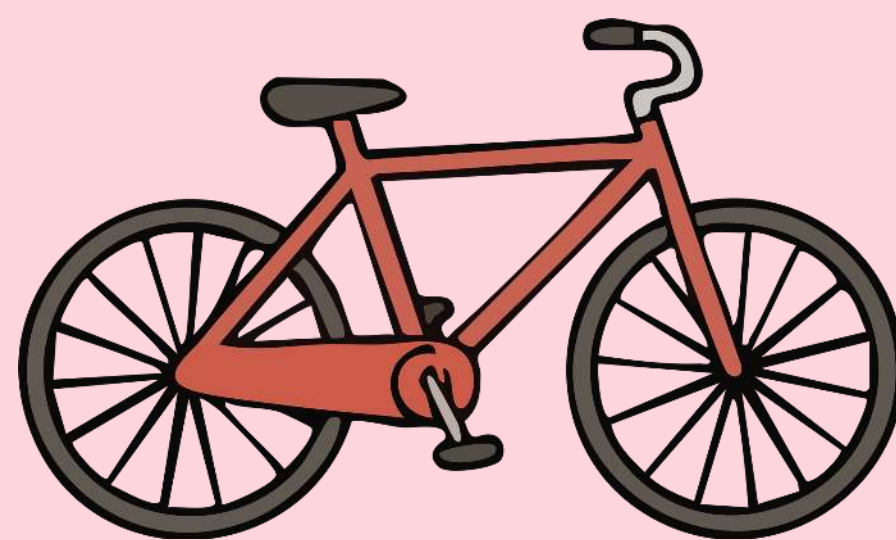
- 🚶 Walking

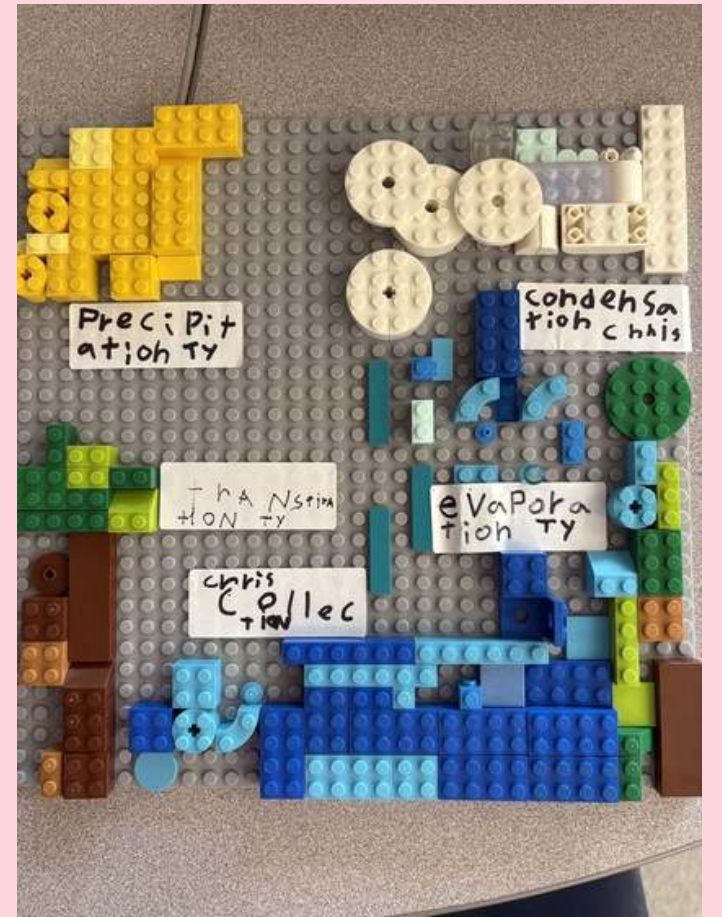
