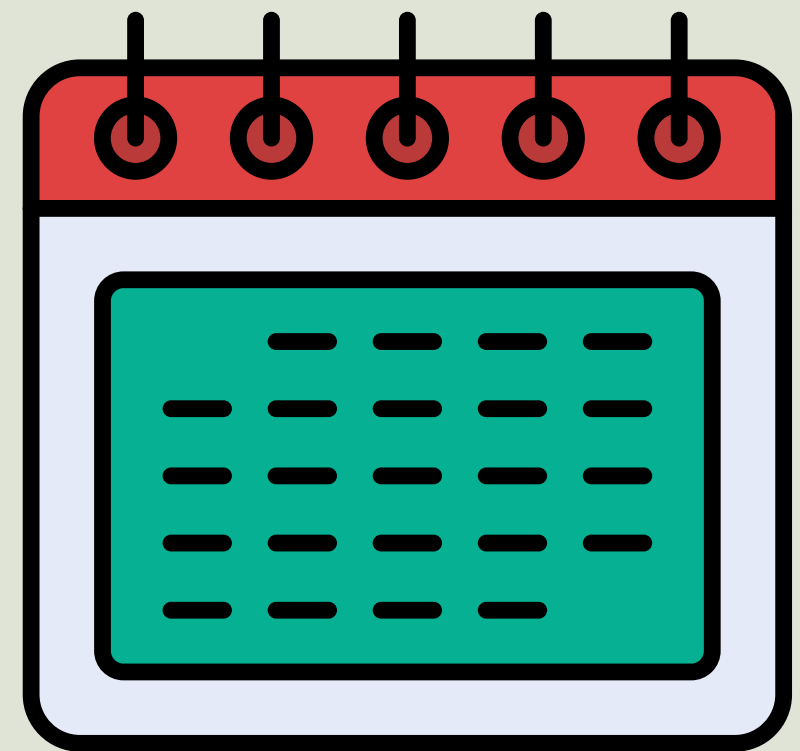

June is:
