School Starts at 8:45am

Being on time is a life skill. We need you to help us teach this to our kids. Our school doors open at 8:30am, a warning bell goes at 8:40am and by 8:45am, your child should be in their classroom, seated at their desk starting class. If you are arriving at 8:45am, your child has already missed part of their lesson. While we understand that things come up from time to time, we ask that you make every effort to try to have your children to school on time.

If you like statistics,

- 1. 97% of our students are on time for school; 93% have zero lates for the entire school year.
- On average, students who are late, are late three (3) times per term, or nine
 (9) times per year.

Breakfast Club Begins Wednesday, September 21st

Thank you to Mrs. Ferreira and her team of volunteers for offering our **breakfast club** again this year. The school opens for breakfast at 8:00am on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays. Breakfast club is held in our gym. The gym is also open for students to come and be with their friends and play.

Breakfast club is offered for two main reasons: to make sure that children have something to eat before they start their day and for children to have some additional time to play with friends. We will feed any child who asks for something to eat no one is turned away. However, it is important to know that our breakfast club should not be a substitute for those families who are able to feed their children at home. Our program is run by financial donations from corporations, individuals, or is paid for using school money.

One other bonus with having our breakfast club is that it gives working parents who are rushed to get to work in the morning, an opportunity to drop children off earlier to get a jump on their day.

Every Day is an Outside Day

One of the things that we discovered last year was that in addition to hand washing, being outdoors and getting lots of fresh air was beneficial for our students' health. This includes: boots, hats, umbrellas, waterproof / water resistant coats, etc.
