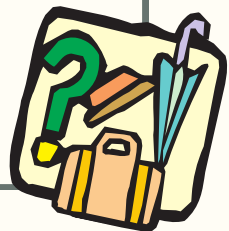

## Early Primary Parent Math Night

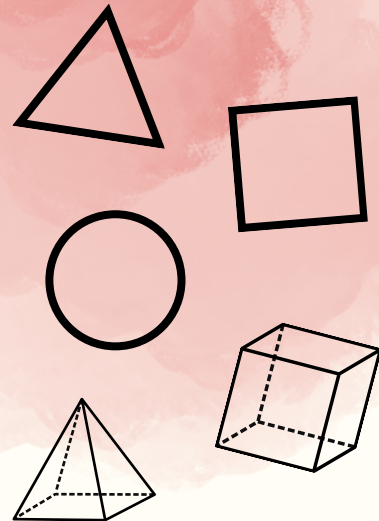
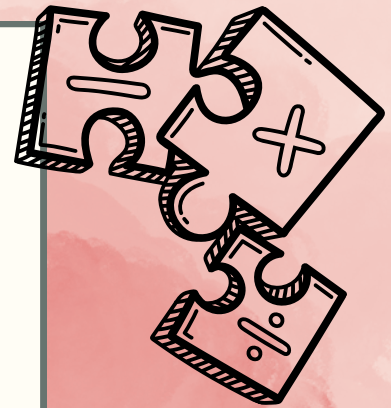
Tomsett is hosting a Kindergarten and Grade 1 math night.
