#### Hello families,

Welcome back! If you are new, we welcome you to this lovely community. We have 21 divisions with 489 students and a wonderful staff to support your children.

Students moved into their new classes this morning and have started getting to know each other and building their learning commmunity for the year. We know this transition can take time at first for some students. Please consider the following information to support your child to start the year in a good way.

#### **Background Information:**

- The process of creating classes for this school year begins in May of the previous school year.
- Teachers and Administrators think deeply about how students will work well with others, the strengths and stretches of each child, and how they will best meet their social, emotional, and academic needs within a diverse group of students.

#### If your child is concerned about their placement:

- 1. Consider doing nothing when a parent/guardian has an open mind, this helps ease the anxiety of the child.
- 2. Give it some time. Almost always, once students have time to bond with their teacher and classmates, concerns are resolved.
- 3. Talk to your child's new teacher. They can give you an accurate picture of how your child is adjusting in the classroom. Working together with your child's teacher will help optimize your child's learning experience, and build connections and trust.
