Hello Families,

It was an exciting first week back with the opening of our new playground. It has been well-used and students are enjoying exploring the new equipment and using it safely. There are a few important reminders below.

- 1. Dress for the weather**—we saw all sorts of weather this week—sunshine, rain, wind, and even hail. Please ensure your child is dressed for the weather so that they can enjoy being outside at recess and lunch. Rain gear, boots, gloves, and a toque are important with warm layers. Although umbrellas are helpful for walking to and from school, they do get in the way when children are trying to play on the playground. Having extra clothes at school is helpful for those extra-wet days.
- 2. Keep toys and valuables at home**—We know that students can be excited to bring their favourite toys to school. However, this can create problems in the class as they can be distracting. As well, solving conflicts due to lost or damaged toys can leave students quite upset, and takes time for teachers to solve. We hope that you can remind students to keep their toys at home.
- 3. K-Pop Performances**—Our K-Pop lessons start in a couple of weeks. You should have received an email this week. Most classes will be partnered up and we will be having a performance for families on Wednesday, January 28th in the afternoon. Please see more information below.

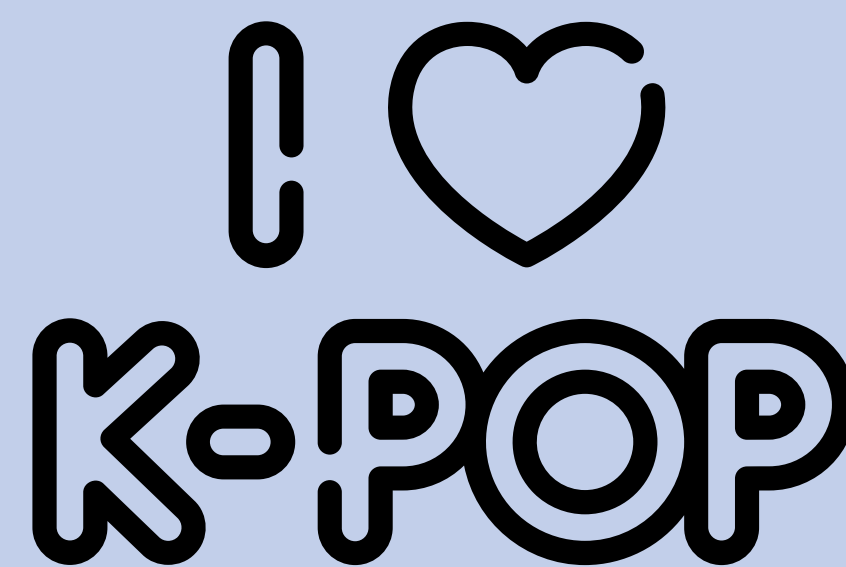

Dress for the Weather

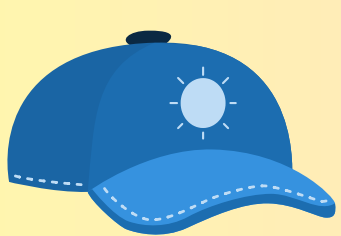
Parents please ensure your child is dress for raining weather, we go outside at recess and at lunch.
