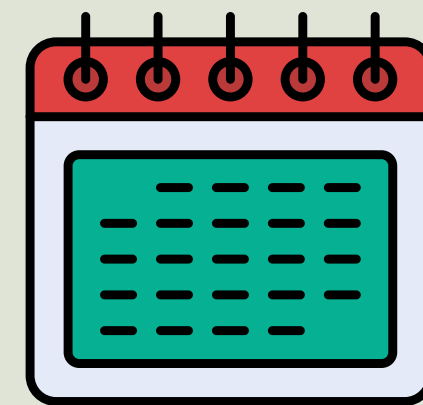

**Portuguese Heritage Month** - A time to showcase the rich culture and heritage of Portuguese Canadians.

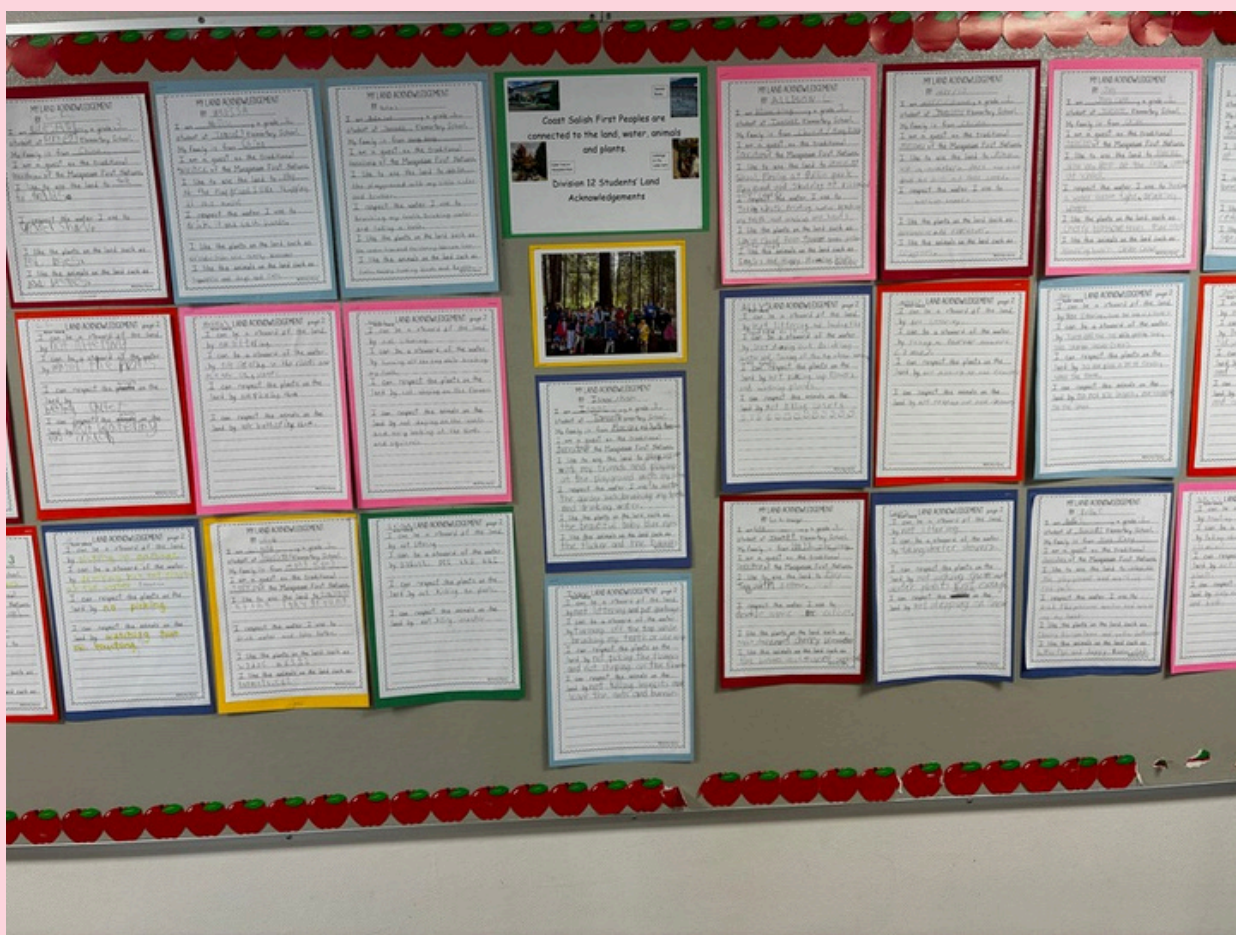

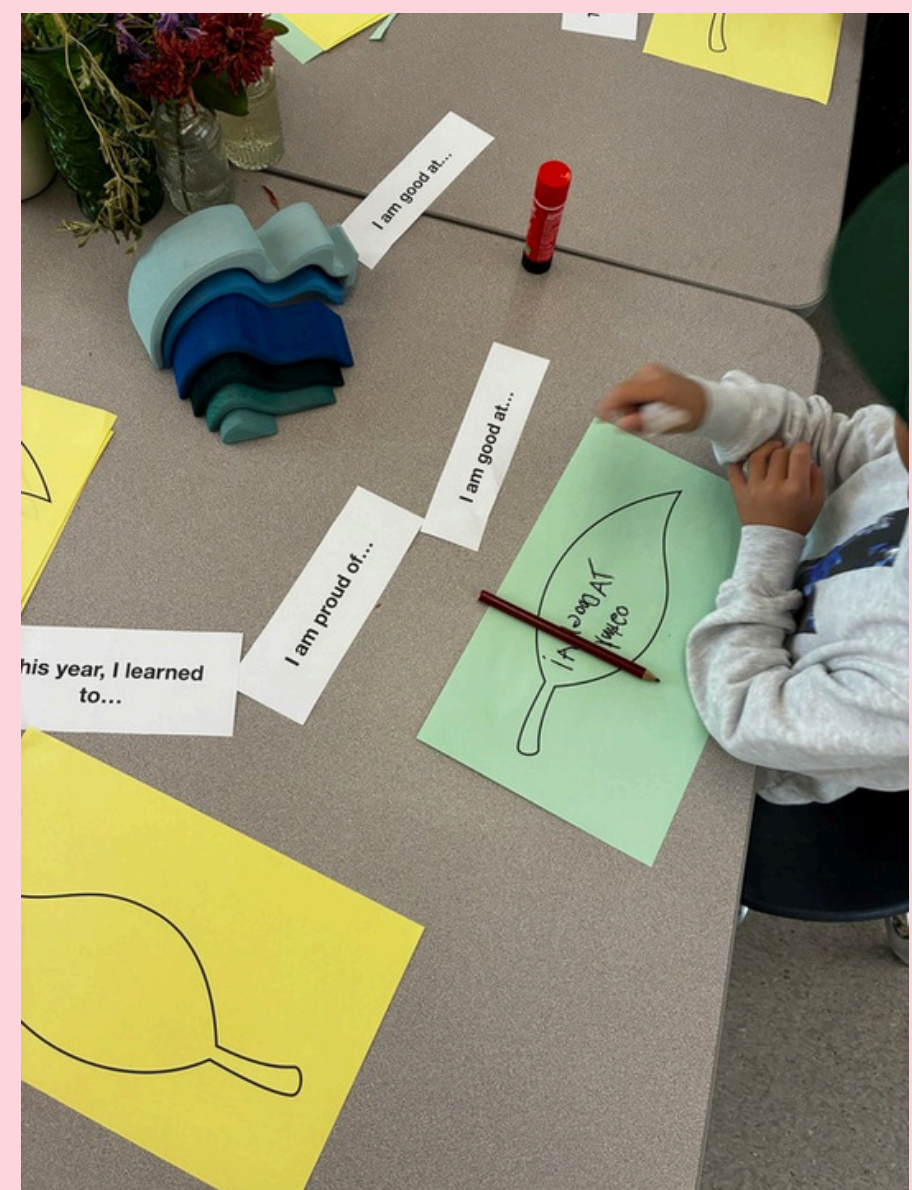
**Glanford Middle School in Victoria came to perform with our Honour Band students this week.**
